2. Honored Guest and Family Accreditation

2.1. Address and Opening Hours

The Honored Guest and Family Accreditation is located at the Hilton Berlin Hotel (Mohrenstraße 30 · 10117 Berlin).

The Honored Guest and Family Accreditation serves as the first point of contact. Here the Credentials,

Welcome Bags and all other documents will be distributed to all registered Family Members.

Please remember your identity card and proof of vaccination.

If you are picking up Credentials for another person, bring their copy of ID and a copy or photo of their vaccination certificate.

*On June 19, the day of the Opening Ceremony, the Accreditation for Honored Guests and Families will close at 12:00 p.m. If you arrive on Sunday afternoon, you can pick up your Credentials at the Opening Ceremony at the Alte Försterei.

You should only use this option to pick up your ticket if it is not possible to come to the Honored Guest and Family Accreditation before 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 19.

Please note that no changes to Credentials are possible on site at the Alte Försterei. Likewise, no welcome bags will be issued at the Alte Försterei. However, these can be picked up retroactively starting Monday at the Hilton or in the Guest of Honor and Family Lounge.






2.2. **Collection of Credentials**

This must be brought to the credential pickup:

- Photo identification (ID card or passport). Children under 15 years are exempt
- A valid vaccination certificate (the 2G regulation after EU-regulations applies) or a correspondingly valid exemption
- Please refer to our corona regulations in chapter 6.3, on the last page.



Only if the documents are shown, the Credentials may be handed out. Please also carry the documents with you if you are collecting Credentials on behalf of others.

The following will be handed over to you at the Credentials handout:

- Family Credential (accreditation badge)
- Ticket for the Opening Ceremony
- Ticket for the public transport system
- Welcome Bag

2.3. **Access with Credentials**

Your Family Credential gives you access to:

- Reserved seats in sports venues (if available)
- Honored Guest and Family Lounge (Maifeld)
- Family Reception
- Discounts for tourist activities
- **Athletes Party**
- Closing Ceremony

Restricted Areas 2.4.

Field of Play. Family members are not allowed on the field for any reason. This is for the safety of our athletes and staff.

2.5. **Loss of Credential**

If a credential is lost or damaged, notify a Family Volunteer and proceed to the Honored Guest and Family Credentials desk at the Hilton Hotel as soon as possible.







3. The Family Program

3.1. Family Reception

The Family Reception will be held on Tuesday evening, June 21. We would like to spend a nice evening together with you in a cozy atmosphere.

The reception will take place at Zoo Berlin. Food will be provided, and a variety of animals are also eager to meet us. We are really looking forward to this great evening and hope that you will all come in large numbers.

Please bring your earphones with you. there will be a translation into English via an free application.

3.2. Opening Ceremony

Each Family member will receive a ticket for the Opening Ceremony at Stadion An der Alten Försterei on June 19. For more information, see chapter 5.1.

3.3. Catering & Lunch

In the Welcome Bag, all Families will receive a reusable beverage bottle. With this they can get water and apple juice at the catering areas of the competition sites.

Those Families who have registered for lunch will receive it **at their Athlete's competition site** between 11:30 am - 2:00 pm. As soon as the competition is over, these Families receive the meal with their Athletes at the Maifeld.







3.4. Honored Guest and Family Lounge

Family members can use the Honored Guest & Family Lounge on the Maifeld of the Olympic Park during the competition days. It serves as a place to inform, rest, exchange ideas and get together. Snacks and drinks will also be available.

3.5. Designated spectator areas for Families

On the stands of the competition venues, where possible, designated areas are provided for Honored Guests and Families to come together to cheer on the athletes.

3.6. Special Olympics Festival: Family Day

The Special Olympics Festival will also be a place for Families during the National Games. **Especially on Saturday, June 18, 2022, the Special Olympics Festival will be held under the motto "Family"**. Therefore, we invite you to participate in the cultural program already on Saturday, June 18 and to come by the Special Olympics Festival.

5. All Events

5.1. Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony of the Special Olympics National Games will provide many goosebump moments. We can all look forward to spectacular show elements with well-known artists, official Olympic elements and of course the highly anticipated entry of the delegations.

When: June 19; 7:30 - 10:00 pm

Admission: 6:00 pm

Where: Stadion An der Alten Försterei, Berlin

Program:

- Big musical highlight: the performance of the Berlin band MiA.
- Parade of the athletes* as a ceremonial entry of the delegations.
- Official elements: Lighting of the Special Olympic Flame, Special Olympic Oath, hoisting of the Special
- Olympic Flag and the official Opening of the Games
- Spectacular show elements

5.2. Athlete Party

The big highlight that is not to be missed is the Athlete Party. On Wednesday, June 22, 2022, you can join the great party with the athletes, volunteers and all those who make the Games possible! During the stage program you can look forward to great DJ sets.

Be there and let's dance together in front of the impressive backdrop of the Brandenburg Gate to end the day with a special evening. Your Credentials serves as your ticket. We are looking forward to seeing you!








6. Practical Information

6.1. General advice



- Wear comfortable shoes
- Plan a little more time than you think to reach your destination. Traffic conditions in Berlin
 are unpredictable and can cause delays
- Always carry your Family Program Credentials with you
- Have fun and celebrate all that your athlete and Family accomplish.
- The best way to travel through Berlin is by public transportation. The BVG app will help you find your way

6.2. Do not bring the following items

Some items may not be taken to the opening and closing ceremonies.

Please also note the restrictions on bags and backpacks:

Bags may not exceed a size of $50 \times 35 \times 20 \text{cm}$.

The security service may carry out bag and backpack checks at their own discretion.

The following additional rules apply at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies:

Items and bags may have a maximum size of 210 x 290 mm

Helmets are not allowed

Metal bottles of any size are prohibited






6.3. Corona Measures

As already communicated, Special Olympics Germany (SOD) and the Local Organizing Committee (LOC), together with Special Olympics International (SOI) have decided that "2G", according to EU specifications, is the minimum standard for credentialed groups of people for the National Games.

Credentialed Families will only be allowed access to sports and event venues if they have provided proof of recovery (no more than three months old) or full proof of vaccination (two vaccinations and proof of infection or three vaccinations) when picking up their accreditation.



Please note: The information is subject to possible adjustments that may result from the development of the pandemic event or by higher-level rules by Berlin / Germany. Changes will be communicated immediately as soon as they come into force.
