Dear Special Olympics Families,

We are very happy that you are participating in the Family Program of the National Games Berlin 2022!

This info letter informs you about the most important things you need to know before you come to Berlin: lunch, accreditation, Lunch Talks and Corona regulations.

Shortly before the games, we will send you the Family Handbook, which will bundle all the information and serve as a reference book.

Invoicing for the prebooked lunch will also be sent shortly.

1. Catering and Lunch

For all sports there is an associated catering area at the sports venue, or in the nearby area.

There, the families can get drinks during the competition days (June 20 - 24*). You will get a reusable drinking bottle in your Welcome Bag. Please always bring the bottle with you to receive and refill your drinks.

If you have booked lunch during registration, you can eat in the catering area dedicated to your specific sports during the competition days. You will get your lunch only there - not in other catering areas.

When the competition of your sport is over, you will get your lunch in the catering tent on the Maifeld (Olympiapark).

For example: A Family that is in Grünau for Kayaking will get the competition normally gets their lunch in the catering area in Grünau. But from Friday on in the catering tent on the Maifeld.

Here you can find the <u>scedule of the sports</u>.

*On June 19, families with participants in swimming will also have lunch at the SSE.

2. Accredation

As soon as you arrive in Berlin, we ask you to pick up your credentials. Without them you will not get access to the events and competitions.

The Accreditation Center for Honored Guests and Families is located at the **Hilton Berlin Hotel (Mohrenstraße 30, 10117 Berlin).** It serves as the first point of contact. Here the credentials, Welcome Bags and everything else will be distributed to all registered Family Members.

17. June 2022: 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
18. June 2022: 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
19. June 2022: 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.*
20.-24. June 2022: 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

*On June 19, the day of the Opening Ceremony the Honored Guest and Family
Accreditation will close at 12:00 am. If you arrive on Sunday afternoon, you can
pick up your credentials at the Opening Ceremony at the Alte Försterei. You should
only use this option if it is not possible to come to the accreditation for Honored

Guest and Families before 12:00 am on Sunday, June 19.

Family credentials can also be collected collectively. On representation or copy of vaccination certificates and identity cards.

3. COVID-Measures

As already announced, decided Special Olympics Germany (SOD) and the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) - together with Special Olympics International (SOI) - to define "2G" as the minimum standard for all credentialed groups for the National Games.

Accredited Families will only be granted access to the sports and event venues if they have provided proof of vaccination or convalescence when collecting their credentials. There will be no control at the sport and event venues, because the possession of the personalized credentials constitutes the COVID proof. More information about the collection of credentials can be found in Chapter 2.

There is no general, overriding mask requirement. We recommend wearing a medical mask whenever distances cannot be maintained. Also, when there are

crowds, you are indoors, and especially when ventilation options are limited.

Please note: The information is subject to possible adjustments, which may result from the development of the pandemic or by higher-level rules by Berlin / Germany. Changes will be communicated as soon as they become effective.
